

ORDINANCE NO 1071

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ROSLYN, WASHINGTON, AMENDING CHAPTER 6.05.040 RELATING TO TAG AND COLLAR REQUIREMENTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Roslyn Municipal Code 6.05.040 currently requires metal tags be issued with the words "Dog License" or "Cat License" stamped thereon: and

WHEREAS, the City has found it more beneficial and cost effective to order one set of tags with "Pet License" stamped thereon: and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires this code amendment to take place with the 2011 pet licenses;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSLYN, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Roslyn Municipal Code Section 6.05.040 is hereby amended as follows:

Upon payment of the license fee, the city clerk shall issue to the owner or custodian a license fee receipt and a metal tag for each animal so licensed. The tag shall have stamped thereon the word "Roslyn," the current year, the words "Pet License" "~~Dog License~~" or "~~Cat License~~" and the number corresponding with the number on the receipt. Every owner or custodian must provide each dog and cat with a collar to which the license tag must be securely fastened, and must see that the collar and tag are constantly worn by the dog or cat. Dog and cat tags shall not be transferable from one animal to another and no refunds shall be made on any animal license fee because of death of the animal or for any other reason.

Section 2. Severability. Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance, or its application to any person or circumstance, be declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid for any reason, or should any portion of this Ordinance be pre-empted by state or federal law or regulation, such decision or pre-emption shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance or its application to other persons or circumstances..

Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be published in the official newspaper of the City, and shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after the date of publication.


