ORDINANCE NO. 1106

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ROSLYN,
WASHINGTON, REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 1105
RELATING TO AN EMERGENCY SIX-MONTH
MORATORIUM WITHIN THE CITY OF ROSLYN ON THE
ESTABLISHMENT, LOCATION, OPERATION,
LICENSING, MAINTENANCE OR CONTINUATION OF
MARIJUANA PRODUCERS, PROCESSORS AND
RETAILERS AS REGULATED OR PROPOSED TO BE
REGULATED PURSUANT TO WASHINGTON STATE
INITIATIVE 502; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND
ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

WHEREAS, on June 10, 2014, the City Council adopted Ordinance 1105 establishing an emergency six-month moratorium within the City of Roslyn on the establishment, location, operation, licensing, maintenance, or continuation of marijuana producers, processors and retailers as regulated or proposed to be regulated pursuant to Washington State Initiative 502; and

WHEREAS, the City Council directed the Planning Commission to develop appropriate land use regulations pursuant to the newly amended law for review and recommendation for inclusion in the zoning regulations or other provisions of the Roslyn Municipal Code and further directed the City Clerk to develop appropriate business licensing and other regulations pursuant to the newly amended law for review and recommendation for inclusion in the zoning regulations or other provisions of the Roslyn Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, after finding the City's current regulations adequate to address any potential impacts recreational marijuana land uses may have on the City, the Planning Commission recommended that the City not adopt additional regulations; and

WHEREAS, the City Council determines it is no longer in the public interest to impose a moratorium upon zoning approvals, licensing and/or permitting of any marijuana-related businesses and desires to terminate the moratorium prior to the end of the six-month period;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSLYN, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinance No. Repealed. Ordinance No. 1105 is hereby repealed in its entirety, terminating the six-month moratorium on the establishment, location, operation, licensing, maintenance, or continuation of marijuana producers, processors and retailers as regulated or proposed to be regulated pursuant to Washington State Initiative 502.

Section 2. – Severability. If any one or more section, subsection, or sentence of this ordinance is held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of this ordinance and the same shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. – Corrections by City Clerk or Code Reviser. Upon approval of the City Attorney, the City Clerk and the code reviser are authorized to make necessary corrections to this ordinance, including the correction of clerical errors; references to other local, state or federal laws, codes, rules, or regulations; or ordinance numbering and section/subsection numbering.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be published in the official newspaper of the City, and shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after the date of publication.
