

ORDINANCE NO 1111

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ROSLYN, WASHINGTON, AMENDING RMC 8.40 SPECIAL USES AND EVENTS RELATING TO SPECIAL USES AND EVENT PERMITTING PROCESS AND REGULATIONS; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Roslyn has adopted Special Uses and Event Regulations; and

WHEREAS, the City of Roslyn Special Events Permitting process is regulated by RMC Chapter 5.20; and

WHEREAS, the City of Roslyn Planning and Historic Preservation Commission recommends the City of Roslyn remove Special Events from Roslyn Municipal Code 8.40; and

WHEREAS, the Roslyn City Council Planning and Community Services Committee has reviewed the proposed revisions to the Special Uses and Events Regulations; and

WHEREAS, the attorney for the City of Roslyn has reviewed the proposed revisions to the Special Uses and Events Regulations; and

WHEREAS, the Roslyn City Council desires to amend the Special Uses and Events Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSLYN, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Roslyn Municipal Code Chapter 8.40 (Special Uses), amended as attached.

Section 3. Severability. Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance, or its application to any person or circumstance, be declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid for any reason, or should any portion of this Ordinance be pre-empted by State or Federal law or regulation, such decision or pre-emption shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance or its application to other persons or circumstances.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be published in the official newspaper of the City, and shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after the date of publication.
