**ORDINANCE NO. 1115**

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**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ROSLYN,  
WASHINGTON, REPEALING CHAPTER 2.70 OF THE  
ROSLYN MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO EMPLOYEE  
PERSONNEL POLICIES; PROVIDING FOR  
SEVERABILITY; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE  
DATE**

**WHEREAS**, the City codified personnel policies to guide conditions for all employees of the City of Roslyn in Chapter 2.70 of the Roslyn Municipal Code; and

**WHEREAS**, some of the policies are outdated and inconsistent, and the policies as a whole do not encompass some aspects of City employment desired by the Council and Administration; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council now desires to repeal Chapter 2.70 RMC in its entirety and adopt newly amended personnel policies by resolution;

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSLYN, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**


**Section 1. Repealer.** Chapter 2.70 of the Roslyn Municipal Code, entitled "Personnel Policies," is hereby repealed in its entirety.

**Section 2. Severability.** Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance, or its application to any person or circumstance, be declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid for any reason, or should any portion of this Ordinance be pre-empted by state or federal law or regulation, such decision or pre-emption shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance or its application to other persons or circumstances.

**Section 3. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall be published in the official newspaper of the City, and shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after the date of publication.
