

RESOLUTION NO 10-012

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSLYN, KITTITAS COUNTY, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF TWO VEHICLES USING THE STATE OF WASHINGTON BID AND AUTHORIZING AN ADDITIONAL EXPENDITURE FOR THE VEHICLES

WHEREAS, the City is in need of two pick-up trucks for use by the Public Works Department;
and

WHEREAS, the City originally thought purchasing one new and one used vehicle would be
sufficient to meet the needs of the City and Public Works Department; and

WHEREAS, the City has did an exhaustive search to find the best price and value for the two
vehicles, and

WHEREAS, after the search and a re-evaluation of the workload and safety needs of the City
and Department and the overall value of purchasing new versus used it was determined that the
best coarse of action would be to purchase two new vehicles, and

WHEREAS, that best price and value is obtained by using the State of Washington Bid for the
purchase of these vehicles, and

WHEREAS, the City originally allocated \$33,450 for the purchase of these two vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the purchase of two new vehicles will exceed the originally allocated amount;


**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSLYN DOES
HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The Mayor is authorized to cause the purchase of two new pick-up trucks using the
State Contract for an amount not to exceed \$49,450.

Section 2. The Staff is directed to prepare and bring before Council for approval the appropriate
budget amendment to reflect the increase in expenditure for these vehicles.
