

RESOLUTION NO 10-023

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ROSLYN, WASHINGTON AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH TONY LIND PAVING FOR PERMANENT STREET REPAIRS AS PART OF THE FEMA PROJECTS

WHEREAS, in January 2009 the City of Roslyn received damage to multiple roads from flood waters, and;

WHEREAS, FEMA came in and assessed the damage and awarded the City of Roslyn grant money to repair the damage, and;

WHEREAS, the City of Roslyn sent a request for quotes to all applicable contractors on our small works roster, and;

WHEREAS, the City of Roslyn received quotes from 3 different contractors with Tony Lind Paving having the lowest quote, and;

WHEREAS, the City has checked reference and has determined that Tony Lind Paving has submitted the lowest responsible quote, and

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSLYN, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Mayor is authorized to enter into a contract with Tony Lind Paving, in an amount not to exceed \$14,337.00 including tax, for the permanent repair of streets damaged by the flood waters in January 2009.


