

RESOLUTION NO 10-037

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ROSLYN, WASHINGTON, SUPPORTING A VISSIONING OR MASTER PLANNING PROCESS AND ADOPTING PROJECTS DEVELOPED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF WASHINGTON STORE FRONT STUDIO PROGRAM IN PARTNERSHIP WITH THE COMMUNITY, ROSLYN DOWNTOWN ASSOCIATION, AND THE CITY OF ROSLYN

WHEREAS, the University of Washington in partnership with the Community, Roslyn Downtown Association, and the City of Roslyn, held “Storefront Studio” workshops during 2009 and 2010; and

WHEREAS, the goal of those workshops was to develop projects that would bring positive change to the City while acknowledging and honoring its heritage, culture, and community; and

WHEREAS, several projects were developed through this public process that the City of Roslyn City Council would like to formally adopt and seek funding solely or in partnership with others for implementation; and

WHEREAS, the City would like to use all of the work developed by the Storefront Studios, the City’s Comprehensive Plan, as well as other information gained through additional workshops to develop a “Master” or “Vision” type planning document that will guide the City in its future development and revitalization.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSLYN, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby adopts and the Mayor is authorized to seek funding for implementation of the following projects, each project shall be evaluated by the Council when funding is identified.


1. Northwest Improvement Building – acquire and renovate for public use.
2. Roslyn Cemetery restoration.
3. Sylvia’s House – acquire and renovate, use to be determined.
4. Roslyn entry – acquire property and develop design for entry.
5. Pioneer Park Baseball Reproduce old grandstands and improvement of park.
6. Renovation of potential buildings (to be identified) for affordable housing.
7. Restoration of City Hall/Library.
8. Coal Miner’s Trail Enhancement.
9. Various small streetscape, pocket park projects and parking.

10. Electric car charging stations & RV parking with possible pay/power.
11. Bring natural gas to this City and the addition of a "fiber optics" system owned and operated by the City.
12. The creation of a Green Park at the now abandoned sewer lagoons - Bio diesel fuel production, wind generation or a chipping facility could be uses of this area.
13. Development of the Trailhead at Stream 3 corridor (old burn dump).
14. Development of "#4" Winery.
15. Visitors Center expansion.

Section 2. The City Council supports the use of the work developed by the Storefront Studios, the consideration of the projects identified in section 1, the City's Comprehensive Plan, as well as other information gained through additional public workshops to develop a "Master" or "Vision" type planning document that will guide the City in its future development and revitalization and the Council further supports the Mayor in efforts to find grant funds or other alternatives to fund or hold those workshops and develop the resulting documents.
