A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSLYN, KITTITAS COUNTY, WASHINGTON, SELECTING A PAINT SCHEME FOR THE OLD CITY HALL/LIBRARY BUILDING

WHEREAS, the City is currently renovating the Old City Hall/Library Building, and

WHEREAS, part of that renovation includes painting the entire exterior, and

WHEREAS, in Phase 1 of the project only the foundation and the front of the building will be painted, and

WHEREAS, the building is of Historical Significance and is an anchor building in the Roslyn Historic District, and


WHEREAS, two color schemes were considered both representing historical periods of the buildings past; a gray scheme representing the current and recent history of the building and a green scheme representing an earlier period of the buildings history, and

Section 1. The paint color used for the Old City Hall/Library Building renovation project shall be the gray color scheme
