

RESOLUTION NO 11-022

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSLYN, WASHINGTON DIRECTING STAFF TO POSTPONE ENFORCEMENT OF CHAPTER 6.15 OF THE ROSLYN MUNICIPAL CODE AND TO WORK WITH THE PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY COMMITTEE TO REVISE SAID CHAPTER

WHEREAS, the current Roslyn City Code Chapter 6.15, Livestock was originally enacted in 1914, revised in 1970 and does not allow goats or swine within the City of Roslyn; and

WHEREAS, City staff would like to work with the Public Health and Safety Committee to review the code Chapter 6.15, Livestock and propose changes that would update the provisions, and


NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSLYN, WASHINGTON, RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. City Council directs staff to postpone any current or potential enforcement action related Chapter 6.15 of the Roslyn Municipal Code for 90 days unless an immediate threat to life or health exists.

Section 2. Staff is directed to work with the Public Health and Safety Committee and the City Attorney to review chapter 6.15 of the Roslyn Municipal Code and make recommendations for amendments to the City Council.
