

## RESOLUTION NO 11-026

### A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ROSLYN, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT FOR EMERGENCY REPORTING SOFTWARE

WHEREAS, the Roslyn Volunteer Fire Department currently tracks responses, inventory, and fills out their annual reports on paper; and

WHEREAS, there is a need for increased communication between the office administration staff and the fire department; and

WHEREAS, the software known as "Emergency Reporting, Fire/EMS Records Management" is used by other fire departments in Kittitas County and when implemented by the Roslyn Fire Department will improve efficiencies in communication and reporting;



**Section 1.** The Mayor is authorized to enter into an agreement for "Emergency Reporting Services, Fire/EMS Records Management" Software in the amount of \$900 for set up and \$129 per month starting September 1, 2011.


