

## RESOLUTION NO 12- 006

### A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ROSLYN, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO APPLY FOR KITTITAS COUNTY TOURISM GRANT FUNDS AND EXECUTE A CONTRACT IS FUNDS ARE AWARDED

**WHEREAS**, the City of Roslyn is a National Historic District and maintains a local historic register; and

**WHEREAS**, there are currently 16 buildings on the local register that are not currently identified other than in City lists and the Roslyn Planning & Historic Preservation Commission intends to invite other qualified building owners to apply for historic designations; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Roslyn wishes to obtain plaques to identify the current historic registered buildings for tourist and residents alike;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSLYN, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** The Mayor is hereby authorized to submit an application for the Kittitas County Tourism Grant funds and if awarded if further authorized to execute a contract for said grant funds.
