

RESOLUTION NO 12-016

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ROSLYN, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE ADOPTION OF THE KITTITAS COUNTY HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN

WHEREAS, all of Kittitas County has exposure to natural hazards that increase the risk to life, property, environment and the County's economy; and

WHEREAS, pro-active mitigation of known hazards before a disaster event can reduce or eliminate long-term risk to life and property; and

WHEREAS, The Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (Public Law 106-390) established new requirements for pre and post disaster hazard mitigation programs; and

WHEREAS, a coalition of Kittitas County stakeholders with like planning objectives has been formed to pool resources and create consistent mitigation strategies to be implemented within each partners identified capabilities, within the Kittitas County Planning Area; and

WHEREAS, the coalition has completed a planning process that engages the public, assesses the risk and vulnerability to the impacts of natural hazards, develops a mitigation strategy consistent with a set of uniform goals and objectives, and creates a plan for implementing, evaluating and revising this strategy;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSLYN, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Volume I and parts 1, the City of Roslyn jurisdictional annex of part 2, part 3, and the appendices of Volume II of the Kittitas County Hazard Mitigation Plan (KCHMP) are hereby adopted.

Section 2. The City of Roslyn will use the adopted and approved portions of the KCHMP to guide pre and post disaster mitigation of the hazards identified.

Section 3. The City of Roslyn will coordinate the strategies identified in the KCHMP with other planning programs and mechanisms under its jurisdictional authority.

Section 4. The City of Roslyn will continue its support of the Steering Committee and continue to participate in the Planning Partnership as described by the KCHMP.

Section 5. The City of Roslyn will help to promote and support the mitigation success of all KCHMP Planning Partners.


