

## RESOLUTION NO 12- 018

### A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ROSLYN, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH GRAY & OSBORNE FOR SERVICES RELATED TO THE 2012 SEWER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

**WHEREAS,** the remaining 1,172 feet of 6-inch clay sewer pipes within the City's sewer collection system is failing and contributing to infiltration and inflow and another 550 feet of sewer pipe within the City's sewer system contains bellies and adverse grades that result in increased sewer system maintenance; and

**WHEREAS,** Gray & Osborne Engineers has already completed design for a portion of the proposed sewer system upgrades, has prepared contract documents for numerous previous sewer replacement projects in the City of Roslyn and is very familiar with the City's sewer collection system; and

**WHEREAS,** USDA Rural Development has authorized \$808,000 in low interest loan funds to complete this work; and,

**WHEREAS,** Gray & Osborne has submitted an acceptable proposal to prepare the contract documents and assist the City with construction management for the proposed sewer replacement project;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSLYN, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** The Mayor is authorized to enter into the attached contract with Gray & Osborne for services relating to the 2012 Sewer System Improvements project.
