

RESOLUTION NO 12-020

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ROSLYN, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN A GRANT APPLICATION WITH THE WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE

WHEREAS, the Historic City of Roslyn, having been designated by the Federal Government a National Registry Historic District and by the State Historic Site by the Washington State Archaeology and Historic Preservation as a State Historic Site; and

WHEREAS, within the City of Roslyn lies a Historic Community Center, Library, City Hall Building, built in 1902 by the Northern Pacific Railroad Company as a community and cultural center for the residents of Roslyn; and

WHEREAS, the Historic Community Center, Library, City Hall Building is in need of structural repairs and restoration as a result of the 2001 Nisqually earthquake; and

WHEREAS, the City of Roslyn, for the past three years has been engaged in renovating and restoring the Historic Community Center, Library and City Hall Building; and

WHEREAS, the restoration is estimated to cost approximately \$3,200,000 of which about \$1,500,000 have been received from various federal, state, local government funds, donations from a number of foundations, and local citizen organizations and individuals; and

WHEREAS, about \$1,700,000 is needed to complete the restoration; and

WHEREAS, the Washington State Department of Commerce has made funds available to local governments who are planning under the Growth Management Act for implementing planning activities that were recommended as high priority projects in the comprehensive plans; and

WHEREAS, the City of Roslyn is in the planning process of generating the remainder of the needed capital construction funds to complete the restoration of the Historic Community Center, Library, City Hall Building; and


WHEREAS, the continuing planning process needs additional planning funds to cover its costs;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSLYN, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1.

The Mayor of the City of Roslyn is hereby authorized to file a grant application with the Washington State Department of Commerce for a GMA Competitive Planning Grant, 2012-2013 for an amount not to exceed \$50,000.
