

## RESOLUTION NO 13-008

### A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ROSLYN, WASHINGTON, AWARDED A TOURISM GRANT

**WHEREAS**, the City Council passed Resolution #13-002 awarding tourism grants to multiple applicants; and

**WHEREAS**, one of the applications was for the Roslyn Sunday Market which will not be operating in 2013; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council desires to help keep a Farmers Market in town to help support tourism and left the money in Resolution #13-002 as an earmark for anyone who stepped forward to put on a market; and

**WHEREAS**, Ben Flowers has formed a group to put on another market, which will be called the Roslyn Farmers Market; and

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Flowers has requested the tourism grant be transferred to the Roslyn Farmers Market in 2013;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSLYN, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** The tourism support grant funds previously allocated to the Roslyn Sunday Market for 2013 shall be transferred to the Roslyn Farmers Market. The total amount to be awarded to the Roslyn Farmers Market shall be \$1,250.00 for the year 2013.
