

As the wildfire potential increases, Roslyn residents should understand evacuation procedures and be prepared.

In Kittitas County the responsibility for evacuation lies with the law enforcement agency of the affected jurisdiction.

We have three levels of evacuation:

- **Level 1 (Get Ready)** - Public is advised by local media & available means of a potential for an evacuation.
- **Level 2 (Get Set)** - Public is advised by door-to-door method and media that an area has the potential of being evacuated and they all citizens within that area should be ready to evacuate immediately.
- **Level 3 (Go)**- An area is being evacuated and the public is requested to leave the area

* In the event of a **level 3 evacuation**, warning will be accomplished by all means available. In a fast moving wild fire situation this may include law enforcement officers driving your neighborhood and utilizing loudspeakers to notify.

If you are unable to self-evacuate, immediately call 911 for assistance.
